## GALLERY EXHIBITION DIMENSIONS

### **Main Hall and Annex - Start to Left of Entry**

- 1m (a good small space for "stand alone" pieces),
- 6.5m in the centre of which one of your panoramas can hang (this is the south wall)
- 2.2m which turns at right angles back into the room
- 0.75m on a column

### **Alcove**

- 1.7m the left wall of the alcove
- There's a pretty useless space with what was a window in the middle of it, sometimes the hangers place a work in there
- 2.5m the other side of the alcove (west wall) not suitable for distance viewing

### **West Wall**

- 5m a good space for a panorama (west wall) if not interrupted by screens 2.5m and
- 4.5m (together forming the north wall) also a good place for a panorama

### **Annex**

- 1m to the right of the archway i.e. if you're facing towards it from inside the annex 2m, then a doorway through into the rest of the gallery where we show our regional artists,
- 1.5m to the left of the fireplace, north wall of annex
- 1.55m above the fireplace
- 1.5m to the right of the fireplace
- 1.2m each to the left and right of the window looking out over Market Street
- 1.4m to the left of the archway
- Then back into the main gallery with a
- 2m prominent position above the desk facing the entry

### **Screens**

- There are also 2 screens with 1.2m of hanging space on both sides. These restrict the viewing space in the gallery, but are useful hanging space, so depends...
